

UPDATING YOUR IMMUNIZATION RECORD

Students are required to keep their immunizations up to date throughout their placement time periods. After completing the Year 1 immunization form, students are responsible for updating the two sections listed below on a regular basis. Immunization forms are available on the OEE website. The form must be completed by the set deadline and submitted to the Office of Experiential Education.

1. Tuberculin Test (TB)

- a. If you had a 2-step TB test that was documented in RxPreceptor and the results were NEGATIVE, **you only require a ONE-STEP TB test to be done.**
- b. If your last **TB test was positive and you had a negative chest X-Ray, you do not need to do anything at this time** (as your results will still be positive).
- c. If there have been *recent changes* in your TB status please include updated documentation.
- d. Your TB test must be valid until the end of the last rotation. TB skin test results are only valid for 1 year.

2. Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis

The expiry date of your tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis vaccine is indicated in RXPreceptor.

- a. If your vaccine expires before or during your rotations, you will need a booster.
- b. If it has been LESS than 10 years, then you do not need to do anything (leave this blank).
- c. If you did not receive a dose of pertussis in the past, vaccination is required.
