KEY ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES:

Pharmacovigilance

- Track, assess, and follow up on adverse drug reaction (ADR) information for reportability to international affiliates and Health Canada, meeting all compliance norms.
- Review scientific literature and other sources for ADRs pertaining to company products or products containing the same active ingredient as a company product, and determine reportability based on Health Canada regulations and guidelines and internal pharmacovigilance SOPs.
- Interact with internal and external groups on safety issues.
- Develop working knowledge of Health Canada pharmacovigilance regulations.
- Prepare ADR reports in Argus and actively participate in the review and improvement of pharmacovigilance processes.
- Provide training on ADR and Product Complaint reporting to internal and external groups.

Medical Information

- Reply to drug information requests from customers including health care practitioners, patients and company personnel and track inquiries within IRMS.
- Review and critically assess reference materials and company documentation to provide scientifically accurate, unbiased and timely answers to drug information requests.
- Develop written medical information responses on frequently asked questions.
- Capture product complaints for the purpose of identifying suspect ADRs.
