## School of Graduate Studies (SGS) - Graduate Faculty Membership Eligibility Guidelines

Updated April 21, 2017

Membership in the Graduate Faculty is a condition of employment for tenured/tenure-stream and full time clinical faculty. For all other categories of employment, level of membership in SGS is restricted to the duties assigned. Membership in the Graduate Faculty is granted by the Graduate Chairs and Directors of Graduate Units with the approval of the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies. All faculty appointed to a tenure-stream position will hold a non-budgetary cross-appointment to an appropriate graduate unit. Decisions regarding such cross-appointments (memberships) will be made jointly by the appointing unit (home unit) and the graduate unit. For those who are Full or Associate Members of Graduate Faculty, the term of membership is concurrent with their University of Toronto appointment. For Emeritus Members and Associate Members with Restricted Duties the term of the Graduate Faculty membership is limited to the term of the duties assigned. Level of membership should match the duties outlined in the letter of offer and description of duties.
