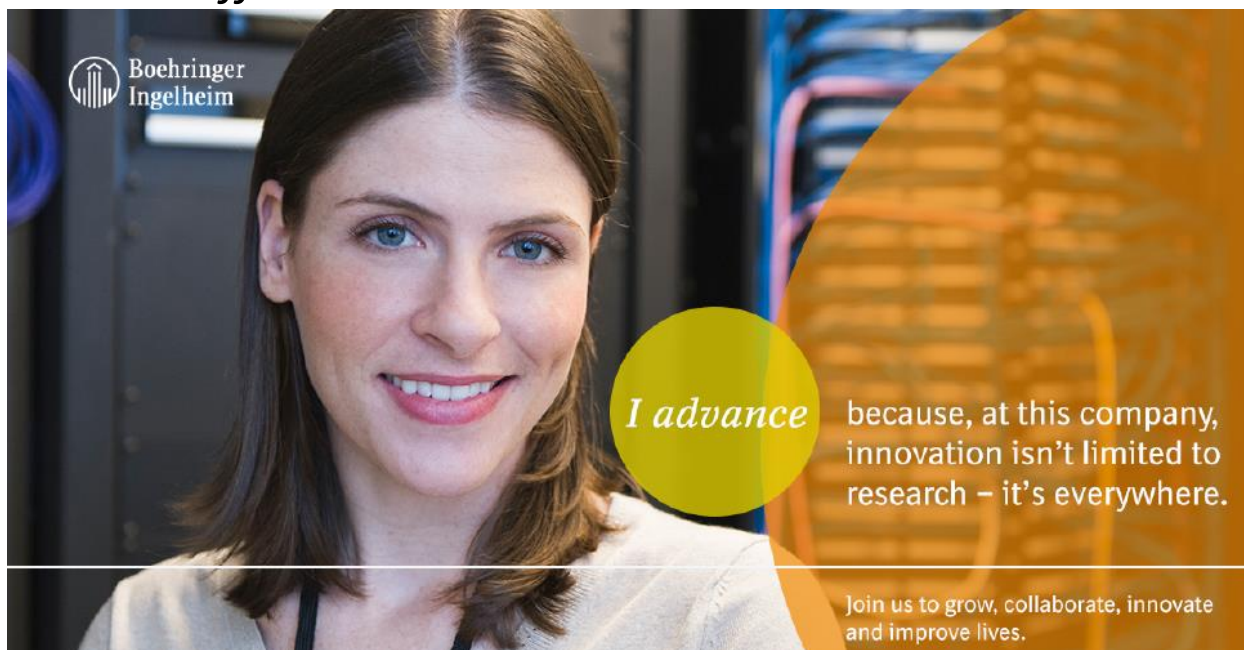


Industrial Pharmacy Residency Program

- Assist in the optimization of medical digital platforms for internal and external use
- Review medical slide kits for medical and scientific accuracy
- Leverage medical and scientific knowledge to ensure that all materials produced are medically and scientifically accurate and in compliance with local and Boehringer Ingelheim requirements
- Additionally, complete a Major Residency Project relevant to business needs and aligned with the University of Toronto's Industrial Pharmacy Residency Program Guidelines
