Office-Based Initiatives

- Contribute to the development and execution of local medical strategies for launched and pipeline products
- Support the planning, development, and/or execution of advisory boards and speaker bureaus
- Advance other projects to support Medical Affairs activities (i.e., special projects, literature search, etc.)
- Support the development of fair and scientifically balanced educational materials in accordance with the Innovative Medicines Canada Code of Ethical Practices and postlearning activity metrics
- Enhance the clinical understanding of Gilead products for the cross-functional team (e.g., Sales, Marketing, Regulatory, and/or Market Access)
- · Participate in cross-functional therapy area team meetings, as appropriate

Field-Based Initiatives

- Support content development for external presentations (e.g., in-services) and/or localized slide decks as they relate to medical communication and education
- Participate in external meetings with Key Opinion Leaders (KOL) while capturing insights through the meeting minutes and action items
- Support the development of various territory and KOL engagement plans
- Participate in research initiatives (e.g., poster abstracts for conferences, discussions around Investigator Sponsored Research [ISRs]) as needed
- Gain an understanding of the clinical development process through discussions around key topics such as clinical trial site selection, site feasibility, contracts negotiation, and site initiation
