Sherif is an active member of the community and the profession. He regularly volunteers his time and expertise on a number of professional, cultural, and political boards and committees. He is a third-generation pharmacist. He was an independent pharmacy owner, associate/franchise owner, in addition to holding progressive corporate leadership roles with top pharmacy retailers in Canada. He also possesses comprehensive expertise in the regulatory and advocacy sectors. In 2017, he was named the Voice of Pharmacy Award winner by the Ontario Pharmacists Association for his significant role in promoting the value of pharmacists and the pharmacy profession. Furthermore in 2017, he was awarded the Volunteer Appreciation Award by the Peel Multicultural Council, which recognizes the work of volunteers who dedicate their time to provide quality and consistent service to the community. In 2018, Sherif was recognized with the Newcomer Recognition Award from the Halton Newcomer Strategy (HNS) which recognizes immigrants who live or work in Halton for their success and contributions to the community. Sherif was also awarded in 2018 with the Coptic Star Award at the Inaugural Egyptian Coptic Festival for Canadians from Egyptian Coptic origin in North America.
